Dear Sister,

I refer to a letter of August 26 2008 from Bishop Ingham regarding relevant employment proceedings, in particular the sentence:

“ Under the Freedom of Information Act 1989 you are entitled to access any documents held by the Diocese relating to this relevant employment proceeding.”

I request all documentation relating to or used for the Diocese's decision in the four matters involved. This includes, but is not limited to:

1. Original records of any accusations made against me, and of any follow-up interviews or communications with any person or body and vice-versa.
2. Letters sent by the Diocese or its agencies or representatives seeking information about me, sent to any person or body.
3. Replies to matters in (2) above received by the Diocese or its agencies.
4. Letters or records of other communications sent by the Diocese to its Investigators relating to this process and replies received by the Diocese or its agencies. This will of course include any reports received by the Diocese from its Investigators.
5. Any records or reports held by the Diocese concerning any of the four matters from previous inquiries, including communications sent to or received from Roman Dicastories concerning these four matters.
6. Written or other communications between the Diocese and either the NSW Ombudsman's Office or the Commission for Children and Young People.
7. Letters or other records of communications from the Diocese regarding any of these four matters to Rev Fr Greg Homeming OCD.

I will be in touch when and if further information is required.
