Dear Bishop Ingham,

I attach a letter sent to Fr J Usher, for your information.

Regarding your letter to me of December 12, 2006, I note the following:

1. The admission that the Assessment of 1998, took cognisance of "media reports and comments" selected by- perhaps initiated by- Bishop Wilson.

Your reference to legal advice being privileged, does not apply when it is forwarded to a tribunal by the client receiving it.

2. The admission that "records of some complaints" is in fact one supposed complaint. As you have not forwarded it, I understand that you refuse to do so.

3. Apparently you believe that the location in which the document requested is filed, is of some relevance. It is not. I understand that you refuse to release it.

4. See 3 above.

5. Your reply make no sense.

6. You admit that you have this report. The fact that it is deemed relevant to the Ombudsman's matter is in no way relevant to my request; it does not quarantine it; if this were so, your release of other material to me, similarly, I image forwarded to the Ombudsman's Office, would have been improper. I understand that you refuse to release this report.

7. Your reply makes no sense.

8. See my replies to 3 and 6 above.

Thank you for your good wishes on my moving house. As your harassment has resulted in many moves over the last several years, including international ones, I believe I can bear it.

I reciprocate your Christmas wishes and hope it is a time of spiritual renewal for you.
