Dear Bishop Ingham,

Greetings from the diocese of Makeni, Sierra Leone.

Your letter dated 20th August 2003, concerning Fr. John Nestor's request to serve in the diocese of Makeni, reached me only yesterday, 21 Feb. 2005!  
I am now answering by email, lest my response would take two more years to reach you.

I wish to thank you for your clear and detailed explanation of Fr. Nestor's case. I appreciate the efforts of your diocese to care for Fr. Nestor and for the good of the church.  
Personally, considering the decisions of the courts and of the Congregation of the Clergy, I felt sympathetic towards Fr. Nestor. However I consulted other church leaders locally and was advised not to proceed with the case. I informed the missionary priest who had pleaded with me on behalf of Fr. Nestor and no longer have I entertained correspondence on this matter with either one of them. I do not know how this case has evolved. I only pray for the spiritual and human welfare of Fr. Nestor and for the good of our church.

I wish you God's blessings during this Lenten Season.
