Dear Bishop Wilson,

It has come to my attention that Mr K Madden, a solicitor I had consulted in July 1999, wrote to you on 30th August, 1999, concerning the procedural fairness of Decrees issued by you to me on 7th August, 1998.

This letter was mistakenly sent by Mr Madden, who was unfortunately not made aware of the recent action by the Congregation for Clergy. I will now advise Mr Madden that I do not wish to proceed with this civil law matter at this time. Mr Madden will no doubt advise your solicitors of this, in the near future.

I have decided to take no action via the civil law at this time, in order to allow every facility for the dialogue between yourself and me, requested by the Congregation for Clergy. It is my fervent hope that, by reaching a mutual accord which is just, there will be no need for any redress under the laws of this state.

Again I respectfully request that you forward your proposals for a normalization of my position and restoration of my good name, so that the dialogue requested by the Congregation for Clergy, might begin.
