Your Father,

This Congregation, as you know, has been studying the recourse you presented for some time.

As the preferred solution in these matters, for the good of the Church, is always that the parties come to mutual accord with regard to the issues outstanding between them. Thus, in an attempt to have this situation resolved, we have asked your Bishop, the Most Rev. P. Wilson, Bishop of Wollongong, to enter into dialog with you with a view to reaching such an accord.

We urge you to actively cooperate in this dialogue with your Ordinary and we pray for its success.

In order to afford all involved the time necessary for this last attempt to resolve the outstanding issues, this Congregation, by virtue of Article 136 of the General Regulations of the Roman Curia, hereby extends the time limits until 30 November 1999. If mutual agreement is not reached by this time, then the Dicastery will render its decision in the matter.
