Dear Bishop Wilson,

One month has now elapsed since our meeting of 15th November. At that meeting, I agreed to stand aside from public ministry, to give you time to consider and consult on the consequences of the 23rd October decision of the District Court of New South Wales, throwing out the false accusation made against me.

You may also recall that in November, 1996, I discussed with you, the steps which would follow upon my being found not guilty.

In spite of the effusion of time, you have given no indication that progress has been made in this matter.

It would always be my desire to comply with your personal wishes even where- as in this case- they are not a matter of canonical obedience. In this spirit, I am prepared to stand aside from public ministry for a further week.

I hope that before this time has elapsed, you will have given me a decision which is accordance with natural justice and the needs of the Church.
