Dear Bishop Wilson,

I refer to your letter dated 7 August 1998.

I have dealt under separate cover with most of the matters contained in your letter dated 7 August 1998.

As to my residence it is true that I am living at my mother's home. My mother, who is 84 years, has recently had a stroke, and I moved from Campbelltown to Sydney to care for her. I had been living in Campbelltown in circumstances which might be considered unsatisfactory. Without an appointment, I have been in a situation of enforced inactivity since April 1996. You will appreciate that this has not been easy.

Although most of the legal assistance provided to me has been provided on a pro bono basis, I owe over \$70,000 in respect of legal expenses. I wish to reduce the debt which I have incurred.

I have been advised that the circumstances in which I was living at Campbelltown were not satisfactory from a security viewpoint.

I apologise for not seeking the required permission. I would be grateful if you could now give me permission.
