Dear Bishop Wilson,

I refer to my letter of 22nd August 1999, offering my full cooperation in the dialogue requested by the Congregation for Clergy. A copy of that letter is attached.

I have received neither acknowledgement nor reply to my letter. I have received no communication from you at all, regarding the dialogue requested by the Congregation for Clergy some six weeks ago.

I would be delighted to hear from you, regarding your proposals for a normalisation of my position and restoration of my good name; I once again promise my full cooperation towards coming to a mutually acceptable solution.

On another matter, I refer to your "Circular to Clergy No 9/99" dated 16 September, 1999, Paragraph 2, in which you request advice from all clergy regarding their annual retreat; I have not yet arranged a retreat for this year, as I thought it best to wait until my situation was normalised in order to make the retreat more fruitfully. I assume you are in agreement with this; if not, would you be so good as to advise me when next you write?
