It was good to talk to you on the phone. I'm sorry that you had such traumatic times of late, but I'm delighted to hear that the experts seem to be getting some sort of a handle on things. I'm really pleased to hear that Mr. O'Shea and the school have been considerate of you with your difficulties.

As I said when we last met, I would be happy to pay the difference between whatever the family health fund contributes for therapy and the therapist's charge. Actually, if you are going to a psychiatrist it should be covered by Medicare. I'd be pleased if you would make sure that whatever funds would be normally available are utilised and then the Marist Brothers make up the difference. This commitment by the Brothers would be for twenty such visits to the therapist. If at that time there are further unresolved matters, then you could contact me and we can discuss other arrangements.

Once again, it's great to hear that you seem to be well on the track and I hope it won't be long before you're back full time at school.
