/**NOTE RE: AB 34**

AT contacted by teacher/librarian of WEI. The teacher/librarian, J Window (JW) had been working with a group of outstanding ex students regarding reunions. One of these students had been approached by a present student (female) who had had a number of interviews regarding school matters with AB 34. A number of times AB 34 spoke with her in French - a language both were familiar with. The student was of Italian origin. The student claims that when speaking in the french language some of the conversation had been inappropriate and some questions asked which were of a very personal sexual, nature. This had happened more than once.

There had also been some touching and stroking of the arms which was inappropriate and the comment was that it bordered on a form of racial and sexual harrasment.

There had been talk amongst a number of students boys and girls, and it seems that this was not isolated. There was also some apprehension among students to go into the office of AB34 alone.

Following this comment another staff member had approached JW indicating that they were not keen to go on the same retreat as AB34 because of the conversation and inuendo as well as some physical contact.

The girl at the centre of the initial complaint said that after she leaves school her parents will make a formal complaint about the contact. This is all the more serious in the light of possible matters connected with AB29.

JW, who is a very noble person and worried about Brothers and the good name of the school, was quite confused as to what steps to take. She is assuming that some action will take place at FMS level, although she would prefer her own identity concealed.
