

STATES:

1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I will be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything that I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.
2. I am 62 years of age.
3. On the 29th April 2014 I made a statement to Police in regards to Brother Dominic.
4. Detective BAXTER asked me if there were any School books that may contain photographs of students or teachers.
5. I have located 2 photographs in the school archives. The first photograph is of Brother Dominic teaching Technical Drawing Class. The room shown in his photograph was not the Tech drawing room when I was at the school. By 1983 it was moved to the original boys primary school block. It is part of the block that is now Food Tech. I know the room well as I used to take over his class when Brother Dominic was away. In the Tech drawing class the kids would have to sit at high tables on stools. This photograph would have been taken by a teacher or student for School Magazine purposes.
6. The second photograph shows Year 10-11 in 1985. The student in the class photograph is CQX . I was able to identify CQX in this picture straight away.
