I have reviewed our old file.

CNJ

It would appear to me that CNJ made a complaint to the Police about Br Patrick Butler.

Our file appears to have come about from the Police Investigation.

Mullins & Mullins initially assisted Br Butler with the Police Investigation.

Br Butler then appears to have been charged in Queensland.

CCI where notified and Patrick Monahan who was then with Ebsworth & Ebsworth in Melbourne were brought into the matter by CCI.

Our file then indicates that a Mr Michael Quinn from Gilshenan & Luton were representing Br Butler.

There is a note that in March 2002 Brother Butler was committed for trial in Brisbane but that the case was said to be weak and Brother was unlikely to be convicted.

As of May 2002 there is a letter from Gilshenan & Luton to Mullins noting that there is no trial date listed yet and any was unlikely to proceed before September 2002.

Our file does not reveal anything further as to what happened.
