I confronted him with this issue and four other accusations of a touchy, feely, type from three other schools. He was quite broken by all of this and when I asked him to get on a plane to come to see me he found he couldn't do that. Then he found that he was not able to go back to a therapist he'd seen earlier about remotely related matters.

Eventually he agreed to see the therapist D.C. and that I should give her all the details of the discussion so that they could get started.

He is aware that the action of <sup>CNK</sup> could be quite unpredictable and he is very concerned.

He had earlier refused the opportunity to go to do the Crossroads Programme but I again pushed this very hard with him and will continue to do so hoping that he will do it. D.C. will contact him today, 30th August, 1993, and the work will begin. The Superior, R.M., has been advised simply that P.B. maybe under pressure and agitated and just to keep an eye on him. Likewise, the Headmaster. The fairly remote contact that he has with students would be considered not to be dangerous at all or providing possibility anything inappropriate.
