Dear Brother Turton:

This letter is to confirm our conversation on August 15, 1989, concerning Brother Sutton's assessment date and the possibility of his entering residential treatment at Southdown.

Brother Sutton has been scheduled for an assessment beginning August 27, 1989. Though you have assured me that any contact Brother Sutton has had with children has only developed over time, I advise you that Brother Sutton should stay at a Marist House in the company of another Marist who would assume responsibility for him prior to coming to Southdown. While Southdown recognizes your need for assessment and treatment for Brother Sutton, it is possible that the recommendation following assessment might not be for treatment at Southdown. In that case, Southdown would certainly assist you in planning how best to proceed.

Please keep us advised of Brother Sutton's travel plans. The manner of supplying feedback to you concerning the assessment on Friday, September 1, 1989, also needs to be determined.

Thank you for recommending Brother Sutton to Southdown for the assessment. I am glad to be able to assist you in this matter.
