

SAFETY PLAN – BROTHER JOHN CHUTE – INITIAL MEETING WITH NORM MARONEY PPSO

Brother John CHUTE (JC) – Interview 18 February 2013 at [REDACTED] - Initial interview with Norm Maroney PPSO.

Brother John William CHUTE is a registrable offender within the meaning of Chapter 3 of the Crimes Act (Child Sex Offenders) Act 2005.

JC has been residing in the ACT for approximately 3 years under various restrictions imposed by the court and the Corrective Services.

JC has received approval from the Corrective Services and the ACT Police to shift his residence to the retirement village, [REDACTED]. Approval has also been given by the Corrective Services NSW.

About 9am on 18 February 2013, interviewed Brother CHUTE regarding his movement of a retirement village at [RE] to [REDACTED].

Brother John Chute will commence his residence at [REDACTED] today, 18 February 2013.

Norm Maroney sat with Brother John Chute and discussed with him his Personal Safety Plan.

1. No unsupervised contact with minors  
JC was reminded of his obligations and the severity of such a breach. JC accepted the requirement. **ACTION.** **NM to contact Local Head of [REDACTED] residence re the obligations.**
2. Notification of local Head of [REDACTED] Residence. **ACTION.** **NM to contact CEO [REDACTED].**
3. No use of title or insignia as a Brother. JC understood the requirement and accepted the direction. **ACTION.** JC reminded of his obligation and the severity of such a breach.
4. Annual reporting NSW Police Sex Offenders Unit. JC agreed with this action and NM will remind JC of same in the future. **ACTION.** **NM to speak with police regarding the annual reporting.**
5. Monthly reporting to NSW Corrective Services. JC to carry out as directed by the NSW Corrective Services Officer, Bernadette Cahill. **ACTION.** **NM to liaise with Ms Cahill.**
6. Regular monthly medical assessment. (physical).
7. Report to CEO [REDACTED] annually. **ACTION.** **NM speak with CEO [REDACTED].**
8. 3 monthly reporting local Manager [REDACTED] **ACTION.** **NM check that [REDACTED] is aware of the reporting conditions.**
9. Monthly therapy. **ACTION.** **NM to receive a written authority from JC to receive a copy of a report from Psychologist, Geraldine Taylor. NM to contact Ms Taylor re same.**

- 10. Reporting monthly Marist Professional Standards Officer (NM). ACTION.

Next proposed meeting: **21.03.2013**

- 11. Restriction on freedom of movement: Shops in the immediate local area, otherwise must be accompanied by a person approved by Marist PSO. (NM) ACTION. NM re-enforced JC's obligations.**

**12. INTERVIEW**

**JC accepts all of the restrictions referred to in his Safety Plan.**

1. Report from Doctor Christopher Aristides Canaris dated 18.02.2013 states in part, "I further note that he (John Chute) completed the Encompass course successfully, has been through prison, and has accepted full responsibility for the actions leading to his incarceration and ongoing predicament. Given all this as well as his age and his manifest frailty coupled with loss of interest in sexual matters, his risk of reoffending or crossing sexual boundaries would appear infinitesimally small."
2. Report from ACT Police Officer Rab ALBERTSON, Approved Reporting Officer, Woden Police Station that John William CHUTE, a registrable offender within the meaning of Chapter 3 of the Crimes (Child Sex Offenders) Act 2005. "He is moving Interstate on Sat 15.02.13 to **REDACTED** He has been advised to contact the local Police Station to report within 7 days of his arrival in N.S.W. That Mr Chute made that report in person."
3. Corrective Services NSW – "Privacy and you"
4. Personal Safety Plan signed by John Chute dated 17.02.2013 and signed by Brother Jeff Crowe, Provincial dated 12.02.2013. When NM and KC met on 18.02.2013, the date signed by John Chute was corrected by him.
