Thank you for your letter of 3 December 2012 regarding the proposed relocation of Brother John Chute from REDACTED at REDACT ACT to a similar facility at REDACTE which is located in the Diocese of Parramatta. I appreciate your interest in arranging for Brother John to reside in Sydney and to be attached to the Brothers' community at Blacktown.

I have reviewed the supporting documentation provided by you in respect of this proposed transfer, and as a result, I am satisfied that appropriate arrangements are in place to manage the risks related to this matter.

I have reviewed the correspondence from Br Jeffrey Crowe, Provincial in response to your letter seeking information about the management of JS. I note that very detailed information has been provided and that there are good risk management strategies in place.

I accept your proposal to relocate Br Chute to a facility within the Diocese of Parramatta, subject to the provision of the following:

1. Evidence of approval from ACT Police regarding his transfer from the ACT to NSW;
2. Written confirmation that the Chief Executive of the facility at REDACTE where Brother Chute will reside has been fully briefed on his history and has been furnished with relevant documentation including the Safety Plan and Assessment of Dr Tony Robinson.


