Good morning Kristi,

In 1997, an allegation of physical brutality (punching on one occasion) was made against the former Brother Romuald Cable by a former student of Marist Brothers Dundas named [REDACTED]. The incident is alleged to have occurred between 1971 to 1975. The claim of assault was denied by former Brother Romuald. The claim was registered initially in the Sydney District Court as a civil matter and apparently dealt with through a Deed of Release in 1998.

Most of the documents, although few, are communications with the Marist Province lawyers and the like.

If you require any further information, could you let me know about the next step in terms of making the information that you may need available in an acceptable format. The allegation by Mr [REDACTED] did not relate to any indecent/sexual assault.

It does appear legal privilege would apply. However, the Province lawyers are Carroll & O'Dea lawyers, the contact solicitor is Mr Howard Harrison, on telephone number [REDACTED] he is aware of the matter.
