Dear Br Michael,

Thanks for your response to my letter of 11 March and the enclosed cheque for \$2,000 which I forwarded to the Solicitors to partly cover the balance of Account owing.

I noted and appreciate your comment about the Order's response to claims from former Brothers, but, as you say, I am clearly in a very different situation compared with most of the others, being a pensioner, out of work for past 3 years and falsely accused.

While I sincerely appreciate the \$2,000 as a contribution towards my costs, I am extremely worried how I can meet the balance still owing. The 'Emergency Fund' of \$5,500 which I had set up has been completely depleted already in Solicitor's costs. This situation has given me considerable anxiety.

Whilst I noted and appreciate the need for confidentiality, I could not bear the burden on my own, and discussed your response with Bishop Pat Power (Canberra) who suggested that there was perhaps a justice matter in my particular case, and urged me to write to you again for reconsideration.

May I say how pleased I was to read in the 'Marist Family News' about the coming Canonisation of Marcellin Champagnat.
