New School at Campbelltown.

It was decided that an announcement would be made in general terms to the Brothers that we would be helping the Diocese of Wollongong by sending two Brothers to the new Diocesan school at Campbelltown. We have made a commitment to support this new school, a commitment which would be reviewed periodically.

Pymble Course.

It was found that for Br. Dominic to undertake the course at Pymble in the Third Term would create awkward problems at Casino. It is difficult to replace him both in the teaching and in his position as deputy headmaster. Sister Anne, the Principal, has said that Br.
