currently is in years nine at Saint Peter Claver College at Riverview. I am aware that the Principal of the school is Brother Dominic.

I remember last year when CNO was REDACTED his mother REDACTED told me that CNO was concerned with some of Brother Dominic's behaviour. REDACTED and I decided not to do anything about the matter last year.

I recall Thursday the 11th day of July 1996. That afternoon CNO was home from school when I got from work. He was sitting at the table doing his home work. I walked in and said G'day, how was your day.

CNO

said words to the effect of I got called to Brother Dominic's office and he started touching me again."

CONTINUED STATEMENT OF:

I said "in what way?"

CNO said "he put his arm around me and kissed me on the head." CNO also said "he put his hand on mine and put it on the inside of his leg and started rubbing it." CNO said "he grabbed my chin and said "your starting to get some hair on it, soon it will be growing on your balls".

I asked CNO if anything else worse than that happen and he said no.

I asked CNO why he was in the office and he explained that it was about his grades.

I asked him if Brother Dominic tried to sexually molest him and he said no. CNO then asked me what sexual molestation was and I explained it to him and then he said no, that nothing further had happened.

On Friday morning I went to the Goodna Police Station to ask some advice as to how to handle the situation. I spoke to Constable BENNETT and TUDDENHAM. I then went down to the school and spoke to Paul Blundell, the Deputy Principal. I then told Paul Blundell what CNO had told me and what REDACTED had told me happened last year. After that I decided to go to the police station again on Monday and make a formal complaint in relation to the behaviour.
