Statement from the Marist Brothers Australia – Brother pleads guilty Sydney

15 March 2016

The Marist Brothers have expressed deep sadness and remorse at the actions of a member of the Order, Dominic O'Sullivan, who pleaded guilty in a Sydney Court yesterday to charges of historic indecent assault.

"To those whose lives have been damaged as a result of abuse by this person, we express our profound and enduring apology", said Brother Peter Carroll, Provincial.

"The Marist Brothers are committed to addressing the terrible effects of past abuse.

"We will continue to work with the victims of abuse with care and compassion to help them achieve healing in their lives.

"Anyone who has suffered past abuse can seek assistance by contacting the Professional Standards Office of the Marist Brothers.

"We also strongly encourage any person with evidence of criminal behaviour to contact the police for appropriate investigation", said Brother Carroll.
