Source of Obligation	The NSW Registration Manual (3.6.1) requires that a registered non-government school must have in place policies and procedures to ensure that it meets its legislative obligations in relation to child protection.

Child Protection Training	Child protection training is provided to all staff who have direct contact with students through which they are informed of legal responsibilities related to child protection, mandatory reporting, reportable conduct and working with children checks as well as other college expectations.

Implementation	<p>This policy is implemented through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The CompliSpace Assurance System where individuals are allocated responsibility to action all obligations in accordance with this policy. • Our internal training program.
