AGREEMENT BETWEEN BR. BARRY COLDREY AND THE
PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF HOLY SPIRIT PROVINCE
TO WRITE A HISTORY OF THE BROTHERS' LIFE
AND WORK AT SUBIACO, CLONTARF, CASTLEDARE,
TARDUN AND BINDOON (1897-1990)

1. The Provincial and Council of HSP, as the Trustees of the Christian Brothers in W.A. and S.A, commission the work, and Br. Coldrey is accountable to them. The Provincial Council has responsibility for the final version of the manuscript. The Trustees of the Christian Brothers in WA Inc. will own the product and all proceeds from its sale.
2. Br. Coldrey is to be seconded to HSP as resident historian while remaining a member of St. Patrick's Province.
3. The project is to be completed by the end of 1992, ready for publication in 1993. During 1991-92, no other commissioned work will be undertaken by Br. Coldrey.
4. The Provincial Council and Br. Coldrey will agree on the format of the book, including length, handling of footnotes, general presentation.
5. The Provincial Council of HSP will take responsibility for the printing of the work in 1993 and for its sale and distribution. Fifty copies are to be provided for Br. Coldrey for professional purposes. The Provincial Council and the Author will agree on the distribution of the book for review purposes.
6. The book is intended to be a history of the Brothers' work in the institutions named, suitable for a general readership of Brothers (in Australia and abroad), former students, former staff and collaborators, and the general public. It will combine historical soundness with balance and sensitivity in the treatment of aspects of these institutions' history that are controversial.
7. Residence will be provided for Br. Coldrey at 'Westcourt' along with necessary work facilities and access to archives.
8. Regular meetings with the Provincial Council will be held to discuss the research and manuscript as they develop, and other relevant matters.
9. Public relations on all matters relating to the history of Castledare, Clontarf, Bindoon and Tardun is the responsibility of the Provincial Council of HSP. No formal communication therefore beyond normal research requirements, is to be engaged in by Br. Coldrey without the permission of the Provincial.
10. An agreed budget will be drawn up by the Provincial Council and Br. Coldrey to include
 - part payment of a stipend to St. Patrick's Province to be determined by the Provincials of the two Provinces
 - maintenance in HSP in the "Westcourt" community
 - office expenses
 - travel expenses to Brothers' houses in WA and if necessary, other states of Australia, and provision of one trip to the UK and Ireland for necessary research
 - the use of a vehicle as required in Perth and for travel to country locations.
