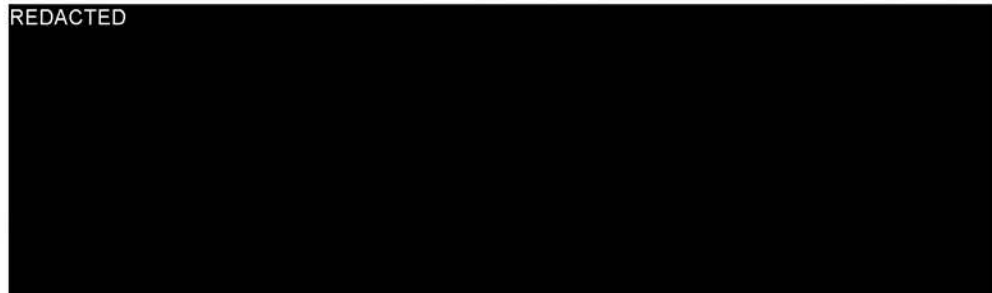

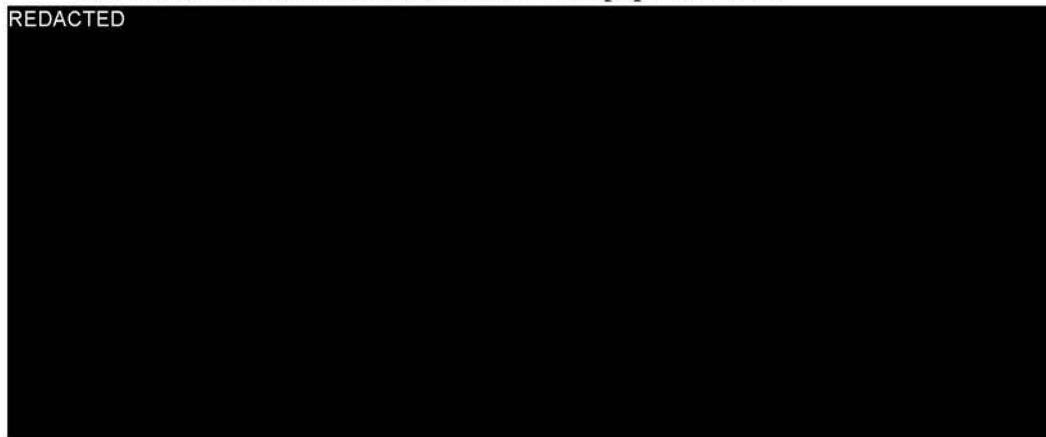
Sister Sonia gave Counsellors an update concerning a number of people who had contacted the Congregation with regard to abuse.
