MEMBERSHIP

Ex-officio:

Superior — Chair of Council
Education Counsellors

Appointees:

Two Members of Colleges as Companies Limited by Guarantee
Two CEO/Principals *
Two Directors *
At least two appointed by the Superior

* *Expressions of interest are called from Principals and Directors. Appointments to the Council from this group will give representation to four Colleges at any one time.*

LENGTH OF APPOINTMENT

Two years rotational membership. Initially, half the number of Principals and Directors are appointed for two years, the other half for three years.

MEETINGS

Two meetings per year. One is to follow on from the Gathering of CEO/Principals of Good Samaritan Colleges.

Other meetings may be called as required.

All Colleges will contribute to cost sharing for the meetings of the Education Council.

Meeting venue will be determined in advance by the Council.
