The Bishop announced that L. Ficalini
is the new Vicar General. He will
remain in Warrnambool as P.P. but
travel to Ballarat one day per
week. This arrangement will be
a trial to see if it can operate
successfully.

Mr. Macrae has asked for
4 months study leave.
It is thought that Mr. J. Ryan could
handle the diocesan book keeping (entries
etc.) with L. Ficalini having the
over-all responsibility and care for
the diocesan trust.

Mr. G. Goggin has expressed a
wish for a change from Swan Hill.

Mr. L. Sheehan has written to say that
he would be willing to vacate Kildura
if the Consultants think that this would
facilitate other changes.

The Bishop also raised the question
of the administration of parishes
while the P.P. is on extended
leave and stated that such
appointments should be matter for
consideration by the Consultants.
