Dear LJ

I write to bring you up to date with the things we discussed during the week. As agreed I wrote to Archbishop Wilson requesting a cheque to cover your carers costs be sent to you directly. Please let me know if there is any delay but I do not expect there to be.

This morning, as you suggested, I have spoken with Richard Bruggeman who directed me to the manager of the Southern regional office. Both Richard and the manager, Sue Deeprise, say they are able to provide a tailored course for LA. Sue will have someone ring you directly to discuss this. Richard, as you are aware, knows the circumstances and background to this matter but has not talked about them with any other person. When talking to Sue I was very discreet and did not mention places, names etc. However, as she was misunderstanding what I was asking for in relation to LA needs, I did have to reveal that it is believed he may have been sexually abused in the past and the accused person has been seen recently in Adelaide. It would be expected that whatever you tell the person who contacts you will be kept in the strictest confidence.

I hope the meeting next week goes well and that you are given information which hopefully will lead to some resolution.
