We refer to your letter dated 20 September 2003 in relation to the above matter.

Please find enclosed by way of return the executed document.

In relation to this we note the following:

1. That the acceptance of this gift does not in any way preclude or prejudice either ourselves or our child of charge from proceeding further against the Church, should this be our ultimate decision.
2. That in the circumstances the gift is received as part payment only in respect of the Church's liability in the matter.
3. Both ourselves and our child formally reserve our rights to proceed further in this matter.

We have advised the Health Insurance Commission of medical items which have been claimed since 1987 for medical and psychiatric treatment as a result of trauma and abuse suffered during 1987 and 1988. We attach a copy of statement from the Health Insurance Commission. These consultations were undertaken prior to the Church's agreement to pay for any treatment. However they are directly associated with the outcome of abuse that LG experienced while at St Ann's. We expect the Health Insurance Commission will advise and request the Church to pay the Medicare rebates. In accord with the Church's undertaking to pay for all and any treatment associated with the abuse, it would seem reasonable to expect the Church to pay the Health Insurance Commission Medicare rebates amounting to \$922.45, separate from the payment of \$50,000.
