St. Ann's

Archbishop Wilson received correspondence from Sr. Loreto outlining her concerns regarding the management of the St. Ann's Enquiry and issues arising in the post enquiry period. Archbishop asked the committee to consider the letter and prepare a response, particularly in light of Paul Slattery's critique and recommendations.

Archbishop Wilson also received a critical letter from Paul Morrissey's son in relation to the way he felt that his father had been compromised by the inquiry and subsequent report. Archbishop Wilson said that the church needed to admit that Paul Morrissey and others on the school board had not been appropriately supported. The management of the school had not been adequate.

REDACTED Anne said that the nature of the evidence provided by staff was not sufficiently beyond doubt to draw definite conclusions, given that it relied on staff recollection of what had occurred at the time. The only concrete evidence that disputed Karen Roger's claims rested with the dates of enrolment. Archbishop Wilson and Sue Cain agreed that a follow up interview with REDACTED to clarify conflicting information would be most appropriate in the circumstances.
