Msg. David Cappelletti said that against legal advice the Archbishop had decided to make the report public as he believed it was important that the church was seen to be transparent in matters relating to events at St. Ann's. In doing so The Church made itself vulnerable to litigation from various parties but this had been outweighed by the need to acknowledge the mistakes that had been made and move forward in the interests of all concerned.
