Actions arising from meeting

1. Historical analysis of material to be consolidated, indexed and archived when legal action has finalised. Currently O'Loughlins Lawyers have a majority of the documentation relating to St. Ann's.
2. St. Ann's to be written up, the pastoral component that has been identified is to be mapped and any action taken is to be recorded.

3. Interview key people including Sandra Watkins, Anne Carolyn, Jane Swift, Allan Dooley, Tony Fuller, Michael Critchley and Aileen Young, to seek any further information they may have in relation to other abuse that may have occurred.

4. A report is to be provided to Archbishop Wilson. The report is to include how many people were involved, how many people proceeded with litigation and how many people were satisfied with the Church's response.
It was recommended that a student completing a Masters Degree in Social Work would be best suited to prepare the report.
5. Formalise and confirm that the recommendations presented in the reports listed above have been addressed.
It was recommended that an independent Assessor or Assessors be sought to action this.
