Dear Laurie,

CEO have now advised me that they have examined the information that they hold re the St Ann's work and specifically in relation to the four matters they have the following:

MA [redacted] - a file note of a phone conversation with the father in 2003 where he requested information be sent to him about Towards Healing, but indicated that he did not want to pursue the process at that time. He received the information as requested but did not make a formal complaint. MA [redacted] was categorised into Category 1B on the basis it was possible and probable that he may have been abused as he had received respite care from Brian Perkins.

MI [redacted] - she was placed in Category 2 because she was on the bus route for the bus driven by Brian Perkins. Therefore it was determined it was possible she could have been abused as we know abuse did take place on the bus.

Subsequent to that determination, further information was provided to us by the police in strict confidence. That information concerned an allegation of direct abuse by Brian Perkins. As a consequence, her matter was then moved to Category 1B.

MK [redacted] - he had been originally categorised as Category 3. As above, the police provided strong information and the matter was then moved to Category 1B.

MP [redacted] -

As with the above two matters, her matter was re categorised on the basis of information provided to us by the Police. Originally she was Categorised as a Category 2.

I would welcome your advice about our ability to share the information from the Police as the agreement was that we would keep that in the strictest confidence.

Laurie, I hope that this is helpful. Please let me know what else I can do to assist.
