As I hope you appreciate, Friday was the final day of term and I was busy attending to already scheduled commitments as well as thoroughly ensuring that the end of term school routine was finalized before the close of school for Term 2.

Since our meeting on Thursday 26 June, I have had a lengthy meeting with Mr Byrnes to discuss the concerns expressed in your letter that you presented at this meeting. Additionally, I have already actioned with Catholic Education Office, what I consider are appropriate and important procedures, as Principal, that need to be followed and addressed in the light of your concerns. Please be aware though, that at this stage, as Principal, I am not at liberty to release any notes tabled at our meetings, as you request.

Should you wish to pursue your option, as you have indicated, of an alternate school for REDACTED, I request that you place this in writing by Friday 11 July so that legislated administrative procedures can be actioned when children move schools. Otherwise, I look forward to, again, meeting with you and REDACTED to further discuss and clarify the best approach for REDACTED's welfare and educational needs.
