

STATEMENT

My name is John Francis Reilly of 538 Wardell Road, Alstonville in the State of New South Wales.

I am the Executive Secretary of the Catholic Education Office for the Catholic Diocese of Lismore. I am responsible to the Director, Mr John Kelly.

I obtained the Leaving Certificate at Woodlawn College in 1956 and thereafter, attended Bathurst Teachers College then Balmain Teachers College and finally, the Australian School of Pacific Administration where I graduated as a Teacher in 1958. I then worked as an Education Office in technical, post primary, primary and inspectorate roles with the Papua-New Guinea administration.
