I have had to live with this for all of my life and I am grateful now, that - through the Neenkal Action Group, the truth is being brought out into the open. It's a shame it came too late for those children who committed suicide because they could no longer live with their memories of the abuses and humiliations they suffered at the hands of the sisters.
