We certify that permission was granted to the Rev. Nazareno Fasciale of the Archdiocese of Melbourne to be absent from parochial duties for a period of five months only, viz. July 23rd to December 16th, 1960.

His return to Australia to take up duty before Christmas 1960 is essential, particularly for the celebration of the numerous marriages of Italian immigrants during the Christmas holidays.
