Dear Father Pavlou,

Last evening Ms Maria Kirkwood met with a small number of parishioners of Healesville Parish who were concerned about the circumstances of your departure from the Parish.

As the meeting preceded it became apparent that you are maintaining contact with some parishioners and discussing matters which have been referred to the Independent Commissioner. There was strong feeling at the meeting that you should not be contacting parishioners and the request was made that something be done to stop you from making this contact with parishioners.

In the letter of the Archbishop of the 8th February, 2007 to you the Archbishop wrote: *Again I would counsel you not to be in contact with parishioners in either Croydon or Healesville Parishes to discuss matters that are before the Independent Commissioner and to make no contact with the family who brought the complaint.*

I regard this as a direction you are to follow in obedience to the Archbishop. **You are to make no contact with parishioners of either Healesville or Croydon.**
