Dear Father Paul,

I write to offer some guidance during your time of sick leave. I propose:-

1. Assistance of competent medical professionals who will work with you to ensure that you have a full return to health as a value priest of the Archdiocese.
2. I enclose a copy of the documentation, which explains how you will be supported financially during this time.
3. I am to discuss with you on Wednesday suitable living arrangements so that you will be adequately looked after.
4. It is important that no big decisions be made until you are able to return to full health and until the situation has been clarified.
5. While on sick leave you should not undertake ministry in the parish of Healesville or do any weddings. This will avoid the sending out of mixed messages.
6. I will advise you in the light of present and subsequent circumstances what are my wishes concerning the possibility of some ministry elsewhere.

It is most important that we keep in touch and I would be grateful if you would come for an appointment at James Goold House on Wednesday next, 8th November, at 3.30 p.m., as we have confirmed in our telephone call.

Be sure of my best wishes and prayers.
