3. NORTH RICHMOND

Archbishop notified Board of offer of Fr. Romanin, S.J. of Richmond concerning Jesuit interest. Matter to be followed up with Jesuit Provincial.

Leave as is until January changes. Fr. J. Salvano assures that staffing of parish will be covered.

No contact by his Bishop to Fr. Harman made as yet. Bishop O'Connell suggested that contact be made through the Congregation of Propaganda.


18. FR. CARUANA
