Your Grace,

A short while ago I requested Fr. Mark Reynolds of this Office to inform your Office of the latest news with respect to Doveton. Fr. Reynolds saw Fr. Brian Fleming, S.J., who suggested it would be wise to fax you with this morning's developments.

Fr. Reynolds received a phone call from Mr. Ray Adams, the Principal at Holy Family Doveton at 12.30 p.m. today. Mr. Adams advised that –

- (a) The police yesterday gained a statement from the other young girl who was in the Church at the time of the incident.
- (b) Fr. Scarson was interviewed by the police this morning – he was at the police station at 10.20 a.m. and had not returned by the time Mr. Adams spoke to Fr. Reynolds (12.30 p.m.).

At this stage I am unaware of any further developments.
