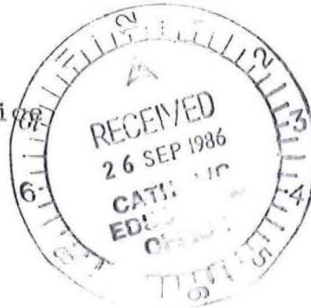

I wish to advise that, after much prayer and reflection that I have tendered my resignation as Principal at Holy Family Primary School as at the end of this current year.
