Dear Father Searson,

I wish to advise you, after many months of prayer and thought, that I will be resigning my position as Principal of Holy Family Primary School, Doveton at the end of the 1986 school year.

I have made this decision taking into account many reasons. The major reason for my decision is that I feel there now exists irreconcilable differences between you and your understanding of my role as Principal of Holy Family Primary School, and between that which I believe to be my role.

I feel that to continue as Principal of the school in 1987 at a time when I believe these differences to be so significant that the well being of the community may be at risk, is not responsible on my part. I think that these differences reflect a fundamental disparity between our understandings of the nature, organisation and administration of the Catholic Primary School.

I would like to take this opportunity of wishing you well as you proceed with the process of selecting a Principal for the school for 1987.
