> John,
 > Nicola has passed your e-mail message on to me. I note that you still have our old e-mail address in your address book.

> I am very sorry that it has taken so long to get back to you.

> The Archbishop has agreed to the meeting between you and Fr Duggan that you spoke of, provided Fr Duggan is reasonably able to participate.

> The proposal is that he will be spoken to by a senior cleric who will present him with the complaint, and advise him that you would be interested in having a meeting with him, which the Archbishop supports. The manner and timing of this meeting with the senior cleric will be arranged in consultation with the staff of the nursing home [not that the staff will be given any specific information about the content of the meeting].

> If there are no significant contra indications a neutral facilitator will be engaged to meet you and Duggan separately. He will then arrange and facilitate the meeting of you together.

> You would, of course, be welcome to have someone with you during both meetings if you wish.

> I would welcome your comments, and whether you would like to alter or add to the plan in any way.
