1 Ellis v Trustees and Cardinal Pell and Anor

We are still awaiting the judgment from the Court of Appeal. We do not expect judgment to be handed down until at least March or April.

It goes without saying that the outcome of this case has huge implications for Sensitive Claims generally. I am reasonably confident that we will receive a finding that the Trustees are not liable for the tortious acts of individual clergy in abuse claims.

Regardless of the outcome, we should have a meeting to discuss the implications of the judgment once it is handed down, both on this case and on these matters generally.

We will keep you informed of any developments in all of the above matters.

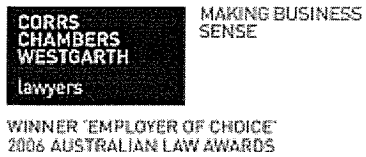
