Dear Michael,

We wish to send a letter to Monahan and Rowell Solicitors notifying them that we now appear for the Archdiocese and asking them to send all correspondence to us. We also wish to send a letter to Mr Ellis' solicitors, Begg and Associates to inform them that we appear for HE George Pell and for the Trustees. In this letter we shall also spell out that we do not act for , nor do we accept service for Fr Duggan.

We will, of course, send you copies of all letters that we send.

Furthermore, we would like to ask counsel for his provisional opinion on the value of this claim (should Mr Ellis be successful) and on our prospects of success in the limitation argument. Obviously, the answers to these questions will be influential in whether we should proceed to mediation / negotiation with Ellis. Our provisional analysis is that we have a good prospect of success in the forthcoming limitation argument.
