Michael Casey asked me to join in on a conversation with Corrs about Ellis today.

The Cardinal wants Corrs to run with the case rather than Patrick Monahan.

For this reason I have withheld the latest letter to Patrick Monahan pending developments early next week.

I assume that MC will discuss with Corrs about how to best run with it and how best to (politely) ask Patrick Monahan to withdraw from involvement. Apparently in Melbourne Corrs runs with all cases and they sort out payment with CCI after it is over.
