As promised, I have drafted a short note analysing the Cardinal's (and the Trustee's) liability in occupier's liability (**attached**).

I have copied in Richard Leder, the Corrs partner responsible for looking after the Melbourne Archdiocese. He has been in regular contact with Ted Exell about the *Ellis* decision and they would both be keen to attend (in person or by telephone) any meeting that we may have to discuss the points raised in my email of 19 June 2007.
