Thank you for the email below.

Further to Paul's email, the Ellis special leave application is likely to be heard by the High Court on 14 December 2007; although no date has been formally set yet. I would recommend that we have the proposed workshop meeting after that date as if the Trustees are successful in opposing the application, the matter will be resolved for all time.

If we lose the special leave application, then the appeal will be heard in Canberra sometime next year. In this case. I would agree that we should have a workshop before then to discuss the current state of the law as there are some very important consequences of the Court of Appeal's decision in terms of the liability of the Bishop of each diocese.

We would of course be happy to have the workshop in November if that is the most convenient date for all the parties. Let me know.
