Following my appearance in court this morning I am able to provide the following information:

- **STATUTORY DECLARATION signed by MR SA**
There is not a copy of such a document in the records of the Archdiocese as far as I can ascertain.
- **FATHER MICHAEL MC GLOIN'S TENURE AS DEAN OF ST MARY'S CATHEDRAL**
Father McGloin was appointed Dean of the Cathedral on 29 December 1981 and remained in the role until 29 January 1984.
- **SISTER ROSEMARY (LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR)**
Sister Rosemary Turner, who was the Director of Nursing in 2002, has now been transferred to St Joseph's Home for the Aged operated by the Little Sisters of the Poor at 112 B St Georges Road, Northcote.
- **PRESENT STATUS OF FATHER MC GLOIN**
I spoke with the Vicar General of the Parramatta Diocese (the Parramatta Diocese holds the file relating to Father McGloin). I was informed that Father McGloin retired as a priest of the Diocese in 1997. In his retirement he helped out in some parishes at a weekend. In recent times, because of some civil litigation involving Father McGloin and other parties and his lack of accountability to the Diocesan Bishop, his faculties to celebrate public Mass were revoked. He lives privately on the South Coast of New South Wales. Access to Father McGloin's file would need to be sought from the Parramatta Diocese.
