Thank you for your instructions to appeal the decision of Patten AJ. I will notify the Plaintiff's solicitor of our decision today.

Shortly after Patten AJ's judgment we received a Notice to Admit Facts (Notice). Attached is a copy of this Notice.

Subsequently, we have served a Notice Disputing Facts on the Plaintiff. Many of the facts contained in the Notice we cannot admit to, due to the absence of documentary evidence or actual knowledge (for example, there are no documents proving that Ellis was an altar server) nor due to the secret nature of the abuse can we possibly confirm this occurred.

I apologise for sending this to you sometime after the event. However, I understand that our instructions have always been to deny the facts set out in the Notice.
